<p><i>Incidental Selling of Insurance Working Group</i> <i>(ISI)</i></p>	<p>The <i>Incidental selling of Insurance Report</i> was posted on the CCIR website in November 2008, completing the mandate of the ISI Working Group.</p> <p>Responsibility for implementing the recommendations in the Report now falls to the Standards of Practice Standing Committee and the newly formed ISI Statistical Committee.</p>
<p><i>Industry Practices Review Committee</i> <i>(IPRC)</i></p>	<p>Industry Practices Review Committee posted its final report entitled <i>IPRC Review of Implementation Report</i> to the CCIR website in December 2008</p> <p>This paper presents the results of the review of the industry's implementation of the three principles for managing conflicts of interest that the CCIR and CISRO have conducted over the past two years.</p> <p>The CCIR thanked the IPRC for a job well done, noted that they have fulfilled their mandate admirably and agreed to disband the committee.</p>
<p><i>Complaint Reporting System – National Expansion Working Group</i> <i>(CRS)</i></p>	<p>The system work on the expanded system, being led by the L'Autorité des marchés financiers, Québec, is on track for a July 1st 2009 rollout.</p> <p>The CRS Working Group is exploring the possibility of using webinars - interactive internet seminars – for communications with stakeholders on the rollout as a cost effective option that will save travel and other costs.</p>
